Tribal Infrastructure Fund (TIF) Portal is now Open and Accepting Applications Indian Affairs Department Opens Tribal Infrastructure Fund Portal

Santa Fe – The New Mexico Indian Affairs Department TIF portal is now open and accepting applications. To facilitate the funding process, IAD has established an online portal for the submission of TIF applications (TIFAs), located at http://www.nmiad.us.

IAD will open the portal for tribal user access on Friday, February 5, 2021, at 8:00 a.m. The portal will remain open for TIFA submissions until Monday, March 8, 2021, at 5:00 p.m.

In accordance with the TIF Guidelines, once the TIF portal closes, the TIF Review Committee (TRC) will review and select the highest-ranking proposals and invite tribes to present those proposals for approval before the Board at a formal Board meeting.
