Sec. Trujillo statement commending President Biden's Action on Epidemic of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People

SANTA FE - New Mexico Indian Affairs Department (IAD) Cabinet Secretary and Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Relatives Task Force Chair Lynn Trujillo on Monday released the following statement applauding President Biden's Executive Order directing administration officials to develop a strategy to address the crisis of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People and to enhance public safety and criminal justice for Native Americans during the White House Tribal Nations Summit.

"The fact that our federal partners are making efforts to secure justice for our Indigenous relatives gives me hope. We are grateful to President Biden and his administration for advocating for this work to be expanded. This executive order will help address specific law enforcement issues and support Tribal Nations to implement Tribally-centered responses that create safety efforts tailored to each of our Tribal communities' own cultural and traditional demands. We will continue to work together to ensure that we are actively working towards a remedy to address these injustices and assure the protection of our people."
